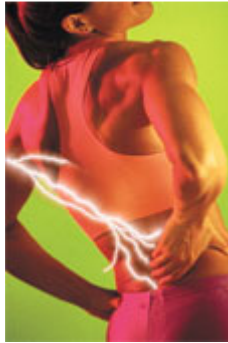

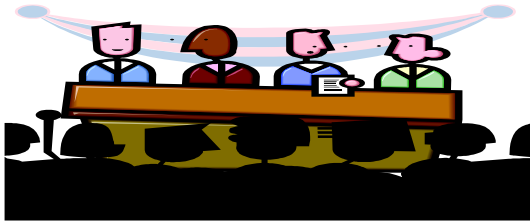

- ❑ Diabetes is the seventh leading cause of death in Wisconsin.
- ❑ Annually, diabetes costs Wisconsin adults an estimated \$5.26 billion in health care costs and lost productivity.
- ❑ Each year, more than 1,200 Wisconsin residents die from diabetes and many more suffer disabling complications, such as heart disease, kidney disease, blindness, and amputations. This burden is higher among minority populations.
